



## DISPLAY & SAFETY RULES

### General Guidelines Junior and Senior Divisions

- **No objects other than boards, binders, laptops/tablets and project paperwork requirements are allowed in the exhibit hall (new for 2024).**
- All [ISEF display and safety guidelines](#) must be followed (with the above exception).
- Photographs and/or visual depictions used to document or illustrate information must have credit lines indicating who took the photo or created the visual.
- Board displays must follow the rules listed below. This is a shortened version of the ISEF list (link above for the full list).

### All Divisions:

The following items are prohibited in the exhibit hall:

- Organisms; living, dead or preserved (plants or animals)
- Human/animal parts or body fluids (for example: blood, urine)
- Human or animal food in any form, including residues
- Bacteria or mold cultures
- Chemicals and liquids - including water
- Poisons, drugs, controlled or hazardous substances
- Sharp items (for example: syringes, needles, pipettes, knives)
- Glass or glass objects
- Pressurized tanks or containers
- Batteries with open top cells (so that battery acid can be seen)
- Dirt/soil, rock/gravel, sand, waste product, etc.
- Photographs or drawings of animals or people in surgical techniques, dissections, or necropsies
- Items deemed potentially hazardous by D&S

Student **MUST** have permission from all people whose photos are displayed

*If items are removed by Display & Safety, you will be able to retrieve them after judging is finished by bringing the receipt to the D&S tables.*
